The Memorandum is intended to provide additional and updated information related to Tuolumne County's Juvenile Justice Realignment Plan. The original plan was submitted to the Office of Youth and Community Restoration on December 15, 2021.

The plan provided historical statistical data on the number of youth detained at the Mother Lode Regional Juvenile Detention Facility (MLRJDF) on WIC 707(b) eligible offenses. This data is collected on a quarterly basis throughout the year and reported to the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) by way of digital surveys.

The last three years of this data was analyzed further after the submission of the plan. A summary of this analysis is as follows:

### Calendar Year 2019

[REDACTED] youth captured in the quarterly surveys were residents of Tuolumne County. \*MLRJDF is a regional facility that serves youth from several counties in the area.
