

California Youth Justice Funding Summary

Introduction

This table offers a high-level overview of key juvenile justice-related funding streams in California. It is designed to support the Community Investment & System Accountability for Youth Justice Subcommittee by organizing information on grant sources, administering agencies, funding cycles, and estimated allocations.

Understanding the funding landscape is essential to the Subcommittee's mission of promoting transparency, accountability, and community-centered investments. The table highlights both state and federal funding, administered primarily by the Office of Youth and Community Restoration (OYCR) and the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) and includes recurring, pilot, and one-time grants.

The range of programs reflects the complexity of California's youth justice funding, from broad statewide allocations like JJRBG and JJCPA-YOBG to targeted initiatives such as Ending Girl's Incarceration and Tribal Youth Diversion. Many grants emphasize support for community-based organizations and equity-focused strategies, while others address workforce development and underserved populations.

Where available, links are included as starting points for further information. Some discontinued or one-time grants may no longer have active landing pages; in those cases, the table serves as a historical reference to inform future funding decisions and track past investments.
