# PURPOSE

  - Other CBOs serving justice impacted youth



# KEY GOALS

## COLLABORATION & NETWORK BUILDING

- Interest in engaging with other grantees and CBOs
- Recommendations for collaboration and shared learning
- Interest in a network of service providers for justice-impacted youth

## SYSTEMS AWARENESS & SUPPORT

- Awareness of local Juvenile Justice Commissions
- Awareness of state level bodies (SACJJDP and subcommittees)
- Desired technical assistance and support
- Greatest needs and how the State can help

**Goal: Understand current capacity and identify opportunities for support**

- **What data and information organizations collect**
- **How data is used in practice**
- **Inclusion of youth and family voice**
- **Outcomes tracked and how success is defined**

## **Mixed - Method Approach**

- Survey + Interviews of Title II Grantees



## **Phase 1: Surveys**

- More front-end work
- Best for data and evaluation questions
- Focus on current grantees first



## **Phase 2: Interviews**


- More back-end work
- Deeper insight into experiences and recommendations
- Conducted after survey with current grantees

- We will need to determine if IRB is necessary
- Expansion to former grantees and state JJDPs / JJC<sup>s</sup> is contingent on sub-committees capacity
