2026 Federal Youth Detention Report Form

When a youth is held in a secure juvenile detention facility solely for a federal detention hold (e.g., illegal entry)¹, administrators are required to report the name of that individual and their length of stay to the Office of Youth and Community Restoration (OYCR).

Please submit this form to the OYCR by the 10th of the month if any youth were held for the federal government and released during the preceding month. Submit the report after the youth has been released.

A separate form must be completed for each youth detained for the federal government.
