ADDENDUM 2 – Biography for Jodie Geddes

Jodie Geddes is an international speaker on restorative justice, an author, and an advocate for racial healing and justice. She has an MA in Conflict Transformation from Eastern Mennonite University's Center for Justice and Peacebuilding. While there, Jodie explored the intersections of peacebuilding, restorative justice, and systems change. Jodie currently serves as the Safe Outside the System Program Director at RJOY (Restorative Justice for Oakland Youth), providing support for community members experiencing a mental health crisis and other community resources. In addition, she is the former Co-Manager for CTTT (Coming to The Table), providing training and resources for communities and individuals to explore the history and legacy of enslavement.

Jodie is the co-author of the Little Book of Racial Healing: Coming to the Table for Truth-Telling, Liberation, and Transformation
